Classic Cocktails

Sidecar

Cognac, Cointreau and Fresh Lemon Juice straight up
in a sugar rimmed cocktail glass

Negroni

Hendricks Gin, Aperol, Sweet Vermouth
on the rocks with a twist of orange

Sazerac

Bulleit Rye, Absinthe, Orange Bitters, twist of lemon—
Not for the faint of heart.

French 75

Champagne spiked with Gin, Fresh Lemon Juice and simple
syrup, straight up in a chilled cocktail glass

Cheapside Craft Cocktails

Cheap-Side-Car

Cognac, ginger syrup, muddled orange and lemon with
an Orange-infused-sugar rimmed glass

Kentucky Mule

Buffalo Trace and fresh lime juice—topped with Ginger
Beer, on the Rocks with a lime wedge.

Johnny Blue Old Fashioned

Johnny Drum Bourbon, rhubarb bitters and blueberries
topped with Club Soda over ice.
